I got in early as a foundation member (www.1cellnet.com/block) and managed to get some momentum happening.

On a positive note, the 1cellnet service works well most of the time, I use a Nokia 6820 using WAP and GPRS with the 1cphone java program. Although mobile-to-mobile call rates with 1cellnet aren't stupendously crash hot, it's still a saving, the 5c/30sec US\$ rate equates to about 14c/min for calls from your mobile to landlines within Australia which is cheap and makes this a very sellable product. There were some teething problems, and from other affiliates I've heard that in some countries there were problems initiating calls, including South Africa.

Works well within Australia though.

The only thing that concerns me about 1cellnet is you never get paid. With 63 cells and 2980 points on the right and 16 cells and 800 points on the left, and having personally sponsored affiliates into both sides, my hopes of ever seeing any \$ amounts appear in my cash account are fading more and more with each passing week.

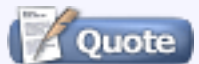
1cellnet is a real worry because they are based right here on the Gold Coast, Australia, yet are pretending to be a US-based company. There is no way of finding out through ASIC (Australian Securities and Industries commission) by doing a company search to find out their physical address, so that I can talk to somebody within the company. The only way you can get any kind of support from 1cellnet is through their online support system that's provided through your website. Took me 2 weeks

to get a response to my query about when I could expect a payment, it was obviously a standard cut-and-paste response "you must personally sponsor to the left and right, 150 points minimum each side to qualify for commissions, blah, blah blah," which is what I've done, a further query a month ago has yet to result in any kind of response.

Another serious concern about the 1cellnet scam is that it's run by the same Eric Cook ("CEO") that was behind the defunct Skybiz2000. I lost money in that scam, and there were never any payments made as per the compensation plan. Suppose the upside with 1cellnet is that I've got my money back by getting cheaper calls from a service that works.

Another serious concern about the 1cellnet scam is that they were trying to raise funds for an IPO from Australian people, without a prospectus, which is highly illegal. Last I saw is a newspaper clipping somewhere in that ASIC (the Australian Securities and Industries Commission) was investigating 1cellnet for breaches of Australian corporations law, which will see the company's directors brought before the courts and prosecuted.

Shame really, 1cellnet is heaps better than Skybiz2000 in that the potential marketplace is huge in comparison (everybody has a mobile), in fact the opportunity is far bigger with this than business models such as Amway or Pro-Ma, shame nobody ever gets paid in 1cellnet though. Bummer!

However, it is safe too say that our Switching Equipment Vendor and CISCO will have that resolved as soon as the upgrade is done early in the new week.

Let us assure you, that the present downtime we have put you through has only been for good reasons, we must now ensure that any services we bring too you is done in a manner that can give you pride in selling your services, we acknowledge that in the past we have not been successful in deploying the best of service and would very much like to avoid that on this occasion, and be true to our word.

As a result, even when the systems are up and running, they will still not be released too you immediately, it is our intention to have the major global leaders and some of their nominated down-lines conduct testing of the system to provide us with some Quality Assurance prior to an official release to the mainstream.

We trust that you will be able to understand the reasoning behind this, and will extend us the already extended courtesy you have provided so far, we too feel the pressure and understand where you all sit, you can be sure that there is no one else that would be happier to see the services in full operation than the company and all its staff.

But the idea of callback itself had intersted me very much, and I decided to learn more about it, 'caz in the Russian provinces rates to some destinations are high and the oppportunity of saving money on long-distance calls and making money on it was really intersting. I found out that cellnet is not only callback operator in the world, there are many other operators and their rates are competitive and sometimes are lower than 1cellnet's rates. So I found a callback company with partnership program and signed the partnership agreement. This costed nothing for me, 'caz they are interested in promoting their services, and this is right IMHO. But cellnet charges ppl \$100 or \$200 for becoming its agents, that is indication of dishonesty IMHO (or indication of pyramid, which is similar to dishonesty for me). And it is dishonest to make clients to pay \$50 in advance without any

opportunity to return the money. 😞 Other operators allow their clients to point themselves the sum which is to be placed at the account. For example, I can place \$5 at my account in advance and check the quality of connection, then if it suits me, I'll continue using it, if not - I can refuse to continue using of its sevices and company will return me the remains of my deposit at my credit card. It's usual practice.

There are many chinese and japan tourists and bussinessmen in my city and now I make some money on them. 🏦 But what was most amazing is that the commission paid to me is much higher than cellnet's one, it varies from 12% to 20% depending on the income. But cellnet pays only 8,33% ($[\$100/\$1200] * 100\%$). The difference is that other operators don't use the pyramid selling scheme, they use merely partnership program which are popular now, so you get money only from your own clients. And the quality of the connection is much higher too in comparison with cellnet, at least in my city.

And did you notice one funny thing? 1Cellnet has no telephone support! It's funny really: International telecom operator doesn't have its own telephone. 🏠 You can check it at the cellnet's page in the section "Contact us".

So, my advice is not to become cellnet's agent. And sorry for my English, I'm a little out of practice. 😊

To Designmindz and others

I am surprised you got an email reply from 1Cellnet. In 6 months of trying they never replied to one email of mine

The new rates are obviously not competitive in many instances compared to standard legitimate Telecommunications companies. Let's remember, the reason they started was to provide cheaper calls than the main Telco providers could offer

Seeing 1Cellnet started in Australia we can use their calls to mobiles as an example

1) To call a mobile in Australia from in Australia costs $7c + 7c = 14c/30$

sec or US 28c/minute or AUS 36c/minute.

With my standard Telco, I can call a mobile from a landline in Australia from AUS 15c/ minute (AUS 21c/minute cheaper than 1Cellnet). I can also earn up to 8% of the cost of my own call as income

I can also make free National tolls to other Customers as well. That is also cheaper than 1Cellnet

One Mobile Telco has free Customer Mobile to Mobile calls off peak

2) To call a mobile in NZ from another mobile within NZ costs $22c + 22c = 44c/30sec$ or US88c/minute or NZ\$1.23c/minute

Most NZ Telco's are charging from NZ 32c/minute to a Mobile from a Landline
or around 45c/minute Mobile to Mobile

3) To call a landline in NZ costs $2c + 2c = 4c/30sec$ or US8c/minute or NZ12c/minute

NZ Telco's are charging from NZ6c/minute to call a landline

Main Points

1Cellnet had a window of opportunity nearly 12 months ago, but blew it. If it had worked they would have gained some foothold in the market

Other Telco's have dropped their prices significantly over the last 12 months, and 1Cellnet is not cheaper anymore. Even if they were cheaper, they have no credibility

There is clear Customer resistance to using Call-back to make calls. The majority of people who registered in the 1st 6 months were business opportunists, not Customers. Most Customers want to only use 2-3 keys to make a call. Simplicity and ease of use mean as much as costs to Customers

IF THERE IS A CLEAR ADVANTAGE FOR A CUSTOMER (CONSUMER) THERE IS AUTOMATICALLY A BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY FOR A REP.
1Cellnet fails on this point. When only Reps are joining, 1Cellnet reverts to a sponsoring program (known as a Pyramid Scheme)

1Cellnet cannot and does not pay \$100 for 1200 points or 8.3c per \$1.00 or point, as stated in its Compensation Plan. This coupled with paying to

unlimited depth means more debt than income is created every time a Rep joins!!!!!!! Refer to our previous entry.
For the doubters draw a diagram with a new Rep joining 20 levels down your Right leg paying \$150.00 of calling time.

How many people have earned 150 points? = 20 [20 x 150 = 3000 points x 8.3c/\$1.00 = \$250.00 Compensation!!!!!!?????]

The new Cell Wireless (1Cellnet) requires a Rep to build in depth and not width. For the company this ensures unbalanced legs. This leaves points permanently out of reach.

How many Reps did I see from other teams who had 200,000 points on their Left, and only had 1,000 points on their Right. Sadly 197,000 points will never be cashed in!!!!

Why - If both sides doubled, there would be 400,000 points on the Left and 2,000 points on the Right, sadly these uncashed in points have now grown to 394,000

1Cellnet pays very few Reps \$100 for 1200 points earned. 1Cellnets Compensation plan effectively bankrupts itself. Interesting to see that actually happened this year.

Global Leaders participated in the deception of 1Cellnet management. They knew the real problem was not technical but financial. The company and Leaders have lost too much credibility in the industry and market for me to be associated with them any more.

I was running my own 1Cellnet, Team meetings and know the industry more than most that join. I have since joined a credible Direct Selling Telecommunication company, which pays 100% of what it states in its Compensation Plan.

My point in writing to this Message board is not to promote the alternative, but warn people from being deceived in the future. If Management and Global Leaders have lied in the past, they will again

I would be surprised if the ACCC will exonerate 1Cellnet in their action against it as a Pyramid Scheme.

My advice to all is, 'Don't recharge your balance. If you can use up your calling time, great, do that and get out, with your pride and bank balance intact.

1Cellnet state in the Compensation Plan they pay \$100 US for 1200 points

A point is equivalent to \$1.00 of purchased call or air time.

You and every Rep in your team between you and the Rep who made the purchase earn these points.

If 8 people joined your team purchasing \$150.00 of air time you would earn 1200 points (8 x 150 points) and supposedly \$100.00 in bonuses or 8.3c bonus/\$1.00 purchased call time.

You can only start with 2 Legs when you build your team, called Left and Right. Anyone who joins will either go on your Right side or Left side

As long as you have balanced legs of 600 points Left & Right or 500/700 or 700/500, you QUALIFY for \$100.00 bonuses

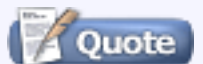

The figure of 197,200 is points not dollars. You have not analysed the Comp Plan, if you did not understand this statement.

By your own admission Cell wireless now delete points after 52 weeks. Previously they stayed forever. There will be a lot more disgruntled Reps, who after 11 months will see all the points in their strong leg being wiped out. Gee I am pleased I stopped being active in 1Cellnet

Cellwireless also have reduced the payout on the left/right balance from 450/750 to 500/700. Less money again to Reps

BACKGROUND

I will answer your questions seeing you are not brave enough to give a direct answer to mine.

I have a direct background in Business Telecommunications solutions, and also achieved success in Product a based Direct Selling company. Telecommunications is my real passion. I was introduced to 1Cellnet by a friend of mine who knew a Global Leader.

They showed me the Text Link Cellular method of calling. It worked in his trial. The rates seemed competitive in Feb 04. I accepted his statements on the Comp Plan. Like any businessman, some risk is involved. I was prepared to lose the \$199 to give it a try. I joined 1Cellnet in Feb 04.

I introduced others to the business, but soon realised the TLC calls were not always getting through. Most were failing. March and April saw a slowing down in promoting the business, as time and time again I would show the service to a potential Customer or Rep, but it wouldn't work.

1Cellnet's Spin Doctors were beginning to kick in.

- The service will improve soon they said
- We are having problems with our wholesale provider
- We are moving over to AAPT who will ensure a better service

Then around May 04 the GPRS option came on board. It actually worked for a few weeks. That is when we got proactive and started our own meetings. We found the Global Leader knew far less than us, and had a very unprofessional business presentation. We would promote our own meetings with a more professional approach

Then just a few weeks later in June, services suddenly stopped for both GPRS and and TLC. 1Cellnet was blaming it on technical issues. We later found out their first Supplier had not been paid, and they also had not paid AAPT, who pulled the plug on them only after a few weeks

But the 1Cellnet Spin Doctors said it was technical and would work soon. We stopped running meetings immediately. You can't promote something that doesn't work, we agreed

together.

Our upline Global Leader kept on promoting meetings and signed people up. I challenged them on this. They said they would keep on signing people up as the services should work one day. (Not our business ethics)

We were emailing 1Cellnet Leaders with our concerns and getting no replies. The Global leader was only interested in signing more people and not too concerned services were down

There is also the issue of Deleted Points from many members accounts. The official reason was credit card fraud. One senior Member from another team had the equivalent of \$100,000 of points removed.

He checked with his immediate downline and found the points remained in their accounts, but as their Legs were unbalanced their points weren't deleted.

1Cellnet saw this method of deleting points as a way of not paying bonuses.

We had had enough by late June. We called a meeting of our team telling them we had lost confidence in the company, and our Global Leader, and could no longer promote 1Cellnet with confidence. We said they should stop promoting as well. I was open and honest with them, explaining the whole story. They agreed with me. My income effectively dropped right off, as we were not sponsoring

Within a few weeks, we had found a more reputable Direct Selling Telecommunications company, which had been around for several years. We did our Due Diligence. We shared this with our previous 1Cellnet team. With the exception of one person, they all came across. Because we were open and honest with them, we had built their trust.

Joe Bloggs, we were open to our team, we had made a mistake and backed a loser. in 1Cellnet. We have our team intact, in the new business because of that honesty.

We also found there is clear Customer resistance to the Call back method of making calls. People only want to press 2-3 keys to make a call. Call back will only have

interest from potential Reps who think Customers will be interested in it. Only Direct Dial calls have any Consumer credibility. 1Cellnet does not offer this. Consumers are also equally interested in convenience, and well as price.

1Cellnet only attracts Reps. It was only a recruiting company in many countries like Russia, where services never worked. 1Cellnet and Global leaders knew Reps were being signed in these countries and did nothing to stop it.

That is Pyramid Selling

1Cellnet won't admit in its literature the statements I have been making. These are the very points they do not want you to know.

The real challenge for you Joe, is, are you willing to put your pride aside, and admit the same mistake as we did, in backing 1Cellnet?

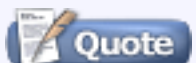
With Mobile phones people only want to use 2-3 keys to make a call. The only People joining have been, and will remain to be, Reps who think there is money to be made with 1Cellnet.

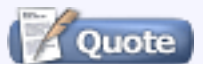
So please accept my apology when I say that I am sorry for using a name that I was born and known by since birth! 🙏

I was referring to integrity of service when comparing Cellwireless and Telstra. If Cellwireless is not confident enough in its services to see itself as a User's primary call carrier it has lost already.

There is no room in the industry for a company that COMPLIMENTS ANOTHER COMPANY for call time. Consumers want to use one Toll or Mobile provider, not two

Customers do not want to use a Provider that works sometimes. Telstra would lose Customers big time if this was the case for them

As mentioned a few times in the past. Consumers have huge market resistance to Call back functions, that is why it is only Reps who are joining Cellwireless. Callback will sink Cellwireless as it did with 1Cellnet. Couple the Callback functions with unreliable services and you have a 'Telco' recipe for disaster.

1Cellnet LLC and Unified Interactive Pty Ltd
s. 65AAC alleged pyramid selling

16 August 2004: the ACCC instituted proceedings in the Federal Court, Perth, Western Australia against 1Cellnet LLC, a company incorporated in Delaware in the USA, for alleged breaches of the pyramid selling scheme provisions of the Trade Practices Act 1974. The ACCC also instituted proceedings against Unified Interactive Pty Ltd; its director, Mr Bruce Pallister; and an alleged promoter, Mr Shaun Mellet.

The ACCC has alleged that 1Cellnet and Unified Interactive participated in, promoted and induced or attempted to induce persons to take part in an illegal pyramid scheme in contravention of s. 65AAC of the Act, and that Mr Pallister and Mr Mellet were knowingly concerned in and or aided and abetted those contraventions.

A directions hearing will be listed before Justice Nicholson in October in the Federal Court, Perth.

1 September 2004: A directions hearing was vacated due to consent directions being filed.

13 September 2004: A hearing was held to determine ACCC motion to serve 1Cellnet in the US. Judgement was reserved.

15 September 2004: A decision was made on Notice of Motion to serve overseas. Orders were made permitting service of 1Cellnet in the US.

A directions hearing has been listed for 15 October before Justice Nicholson in the Federal Court, Perth.

27 October 2004: A directions hearing has been listed for 11 February 2005 before Justice Nicholson in the Federal Court, Perth, to programme the matter to trial.

I wouldn't say that. I still have not had any cash account money successfully transferred to my personal bank account.

I've been involved in the BS company since April and if I could get a refund on all the money I have invested in it and walk away (or turn back time and have had nothing to do with it) I would, but clearly that's not going to happen.

This is my take on the business to date.

The compensation plan is a joke, you will never make any money or run a viable business through this company unless something dramatically changes.

It's clear to me that while it is possible to get paid a bonus run, I have been paid once, it is impossible to have this money transferred to your personal bank account....they just want you to re-invest the money back into airtime.

I am based in Australia but have been in New Zealand for the past 3 weeks, the service here is very fragmented which they freely admit, it is about 1 call in 4 which connects so it's not a viable business tool, and even if it did work perfectly the two leg charge rate in New Zealand is not at all competitive.

In Australia the service does work well. I have a pre-paid mobile and calls through Cellwireless are competitive, approx 35c p/min where as pre-paid is 60c and I use GPRS to connect my calls through 1cphone instead of paying for the text message so I will continue to use the service at this time - the pending monthly charges could change my mind on this very quickly though.

In hindsight I should have just signed up as a 'customer' and used the service to make calls, however I went into this from a business point of view, built websites and invested a lot of my time and money into

marketing...and we all know the end result which is why we are all on scam.com

I like the technology, I believe it is the future of telecommunication, but I don't think you'll make any money in this MLM business, its too dishonest and self serving.

If Arizona Aircraft Spares can prove me wrong I will be a happy man.

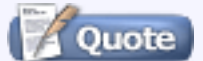

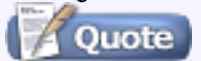

1) The 3000 points in my example are the total points allocated FROM ONE PURCHASE OVER 20 LEVELS. So one purchase of \$150.00 earns 20 Upline Reps 150 points each, or \$12.50 potential bonus waiting to be cashed in (\$250 total)

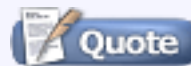

- 3) Reps on Levels 1, 2, 3, and 4 max out on \$20,000 income a week
- 4) Allowing for Levels 1-4 maxing out, the income earned from Levels 1 to 19 equals **\$225,314,361 in bonuses**

Rep bonuses are 1.43 times larger than sales, due to paying 8.3c/dollar down
20 levels

12 Levels

Notes:

- 1) We assume all up line Reps, levels 1-11 are qualified for receiving bonuses
- 2) New Reps join at every available place on level 12 only
- 3) All purchases have happened over a 1 week period
- 4) The figures are more realistic, due to only going down 12 levels,

Outcomes

- 1) There would be 4,096 Reps on Level 12 (2x2x2x2 growth etc..)
- 2) There are **\$614,400 of sales** up 11 Levels just from Level 12
- 3) Reps on Levels 1, 2 max out on \$20,000 income a week
- 4) Allowing for Levels 1-2 maxing out at \$20,000, the income earned from Levels 1 to 12 equals **\$571,998 in bonuses**

Notes:

- 1) On a 1 week cycle, Rep bonuses are 93% of sales, due to the top 2 levels of Reps 'maxing out' at \$20,000/week. (Little money is remaining to pay Suppliers and to run the business)
- 2) On a 2 or more weeks cycle Rep bonuses are 100% of sales, and all income would be needed to fund the Comp Plan. No Rep would 'max out'

Summary

The greater the depth in levels used for receiving points the worst position the company finds itself in

These examples allowed for Senior Reps maxing out, but showed this had little effect on the imbalance in sales (Cellwireless income) and bonuses (Reps income).

Anyone with a Spreadsheet program can do this exercise, and prove my concerns as being accurate and factually based

Cellwireless cannot honor a Comp Plan that pays 8.3% per level down unlimited levels. If it does not change it's Comp Plan it will collapse.

Many people thought it was the Directors, or bad management alone, that caused 1Cellnet to fold. 1Cellnet's Comp Plan was one of the main problems. They were paying out big sums to a few top Reps

and didn't have enough left to pay their Suppliers. Suppliers cut services and the rest is well documented history for 2004

Cellwireless is using the same program with a few minor changes.

Cellwireless can make changes that will solve the problem, but it would need to include flushing unbalanced points after a very short period of time. Binary Compensation Plans cannot have a 'Cut off' after a set number of levels, due to their forced narrow structure.

To help themselves, Cellwireless will need to disadvantage the Reps ability to accumulate points. For Cellwireless, to continue with the status quo with its Comp Plan is deceiving it's members, and shortening its own life.

Flushing points after 52 weeks, is too late to solve the Comp Plan problems.

Level 20 example

1,048,576 Repls join below the 19th Level x \$150 = \$157,286,400 sales

Note: 524,288 Repls join in the Left Leg - 524,288 Repls join in the Right Leg

For those not good in Math (20 Levels x 8.33% bonus per level = 170% of sales to feed the Comp Plan*)


*Less 'Maxed out' Repls (\$20,000 max bonuses per week)

These numbers are highly unlikely. The outcomes of 20 Levels deep (unlimited depth) were needed to show the flaws in the Comp Plan.

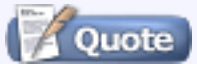

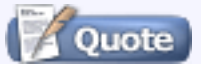

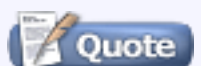

The Comp Plan is probably the most serious flaw in Cellwireless. Even if services worked all over the world, Cellwireless could not stay in business with the Comp Plan in its current format.

Can someone in 1Cellnet like to admit what went wrong

- 1 - Were the tariffs too low compared to supply price?
- 2 - Were the overheads too high, or
- 3 - Was 1Cellnet paying out more in bonuses than it received in sales'**



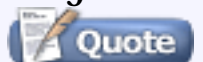

without a question.

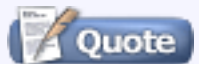
1Cellnet's Management and Global Leaders need to be held accountable by the legal process, for the dabacle of 2004. They cannot hide behind a new company Umbrella.



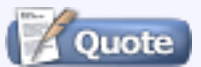

At least you have shown you are reading the Posts now! I am pleased you decided to do some calculations.

Your example with your stated outcome, shows how many people perceive the Compensation Plan. There is a misunderstanding with many people about the compounding effect of points at each Level

For the example,

- we will leave A's own points out of the equation (150 points)
- no points are allocated to the Rep on their own Level for their own purchase

Compounding effect up the Levels

L5 Sales create 9,600 points (16 x 150 points = 2,400 points x 4 Levels)

L4 Sales create 3,600 points (8 x 150 points = 1,200 points x 3 Levels)

L3 Sales create 1,200 points (4 x 150 points = 600 points x 2 Levels)

L2 Sales create 300 points (2 x 150 points = 300 points x 1 Level)

Total of 14,700 points allocated

The deeper the Levels the more compounding effect there is on points earned at each Level.

A earns \$300 with 900 points in reserve

B earns \$100 with 900 points in reserve

C earns \$100 with 900 points in reserve

4 Reps on Level 3 have 900 points in reserve each (3,600 points)

8 Reps on Level 4 have 300 points in reserve each (2,400 points)

Total of 8,700 points in reserve and \$500.00 in bonuses

8700 points in reserve x 8.3% = \$722.00 of potential bonuses
(+ \$500.00 paid)

A total of 14,700 points are allocated to Tiamanawa's example, not 4,500 points.

Notes:

1) No points have been allocated to the 16 Reps on Level 5 for their own purchases, or any other Reps for their own purchases. 1Cellnet used to allocate points to an Affiliate when they registered. If this is the case with Cellwireless, the total points allocated would increase in this example.

2) If each Rep received 150 points themselves when registering, you can add another 4,500 points to Tiamanawa's example (19,200 plus A's points = 19,350 total points)

19,200 points - 6000 points (\$500.00 bonuses) = 13,200 points in Reserve

13,200 points in reserve x 8.3% = \$1095.00 potential extra bonuses
(+ \$500.00 paid)

What does this all prove about Cellwireless's Comp plan.

1) It allocates more points from the same sale, the more levels up points track

2) It eventually allocates more bonuses than income from a Sale

3) It will fail, owing Reps money just like 1Cellnet did

The same Comp Plan* with a different company = The same outcome

(*minor incidental changes)

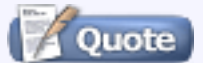

Any Public company trading on the Stock exchange is open to more scrutiny than a Private company. That is correct. Being 'listed' though, does not automatically 'sanctify' the business operation or the Directors. Enron is a prime example of that. Investigations after the Enron collapse revealed many Public companies were overstating profitability for various market reasons.

If Cellwireless's operations are halted, the Public shell could look at alternative businesses. As long as they are not insolvent or in breach of legal or accounting laws, they could start another operation.

It would appear the Directors of Arizona Aircraft Spares have not done their thorough 'Due Diligence' before taking over the shell and assets of 1Cellnet.

It would be our understanding that having new ownership, does not legally protect the 1Cellnet Directors and Global Leaders, of events that occurred during 2004.

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
